I hope you are well and enjoying the summer. Our activities will start next autumn, and I have prepared the following so far. I hope you can participate:

On October 10th, "Olive Oil Mill Visit" (Lagar dos Pardieiros) - In this guided tour, we will discover the olives' journey from tree to mill: see how they are cared for and picked, how they are carefully selected and washed in thermal waters, given that the mill is located in proximity to the waters of Fonte Santa, and, lastly, how they are crushed with millstones. The oil is extracted using ancient traditional cold pressing and decanting methods. The Pardieiros Olive Mill in Alferce, in the municipality of Monchique, produces extra-virgin olive oil. It is run by a highly-committed and passionate family, now into their third generation of producers. At the end of the visit, we will be able to taste a special selection of their best olive oils and if you wish, also buy any of their products. Guided tour of a historic oil mill, explanation of the traditional production process and tasting of selected olive oils:

After the visit to the mill, we will be able to have lunch in a nearby family run restaurant called "Malhada Quente", very simple but famous for its chicken piri piri and other authentic Portuguese specialties, mainly grilled meat. You pay for what you order, "à la carte" and the average price per person is around €15/ €20. Please let me know if you will be interested in having lunch too.

On October 30th, "Balconies above the sea trail" - this is a spectacular walking tour guided by Miguel Rodrigues, who showed us the flora and fauna of Alvor Ebio Station last spring. This itinerary is one of the most beautiful sections of Portimão's rocky coast, along the top of a limestone cliff dating back to the Miocene (23 to 5 million years ago). The rocks are now very worn by the sea, rain and run-off, as well as by the action of the wind and the plants, and with different reddish hues caused by the oxidation of the limestone. The rocks, sculpted by erosion, shelter numerous species of birds, in particular jackdaws and rock pigeons, the forebears of the domestic pigeon. Along the way we will come across Mediterranean scrub vegetation with mastic and scattered stone pine trees, as well as encountering various birds, including Sardinian warblers and European robins.

On November 20th, "Food Tour" at Mercado Municipal de Portimão - local market. This authentic food tour will be guided by the professional pastry chef Tiago, from Almareada Food Tours. We will learn about local products and sample local delicacies. A cultural food experience to better understand the flavors and taste of the Algarve cuisine.

This approximately 2 hours tour includes the following:

- Guided visit to the fish market and fruit/vegetable market
- Tasting of 4 sweets (individual portions)
- Tasting of regional charcuterie
- Tasting of 1-2 fruits per persons
- Surprise tasting at the market
- Typical sandwich with 1 drink (wine/beer/water) if it's not a sandwich it could be something else, it can vary
- Tasting of a local liqueur, typical of the region
